We DO NOT treat

- Ongoing problems and/or problems already seen by GP/ A&E / other walk in centre including second opinions.
- Repeat prescriptions
- Eczema
- Eye injuries
- Nappy rash
- Headaches
- Asthma
- Worms / scabies or head lice
- Second opinions.
- Ingestion of poisons/overdose
- Menstrual problems, emergency contraception or pregnancy problems.
- Mental health problems
- Drug / alcohol problems
- Road traffic accidents
- Assault injuries
- Anything more than a minor injury or a minor illness

We DO treat

Minor injuries such as:

- New wounds, cuts and grazes
- Minor burns and scalds
- Insect or animal bites
- Minor head injuries
- Sprains and strains

Minor illnesses such as:

- Coughs, colds and fevers
- Sore throats and earaches
- Minor eye infections
- Diarrhoea and/or vomiting
- Skin infections
- Possible urine infections

The paediatric nurse practitioner will refer you back to your GP if they feel it is more appropriate.
